## Change Management , Resistance to change

Effective Change management process by having right mindset. In today's environment where customer expectation & demands are at peak, Customer collaboration is the need.

## Architectural issues :

Welcome change even if it arrives late. There can be two primary reasons a) gaps in requirement gathering and understanding b) change in architecture due to change in business requirements.

- Integration issues

Once the project is in build phase or implementation phase, product or integration defects are seen. Strong quality control mechanisms like audits can help the product in meeting the customers quality expectations.

- POTENTIAL ISSUES = RISK
- Risk identification as early as possible in the project.
  - Operational Management
  - Steering group members.
  - Project & Program teams.


RISK are POSITIVE & NEGATIVE. Positive risk result in opportunity & negative risk result in threats.


